Little Cottonwood Canyon was blessed with 800+ inches of snow this past winter season. The Snowbird 2010/2011 ski season was extended this year as the mountain was packed with skiers on July 4th! We want to remind you of some safety tips that will enhance your travels to Snowbird. Heavy snow can make traveling a unique challenge.

Please be aware that the canyon road can be restricted to vehicles that are 4-wheel drive or have tire chains. Salt Lake County ordinances require that all vehicles



be equipped with snow tires or have tire chains available in the vehicle. Please make sure your vehicle is properly equipped prior to traveling. Road updates can be obtained by calling 801-933-2100. Additionally, snow conditions can close the canyon road on very short notice.

Our staff strives to keep travelers and Lodge guests informed of road closures when notified by the Utah Department of Transportation. During storm periods please watch for notices and updates on Snowbird's in-house television and Iron Blossam's elevator marquees. It is also important that we keep our parking areas and access areas clear of

snow. Snow removal crews will work throughout the night to keep parking areas accessible. Please make sure to obtain an Iron Blossam parking pass and display it visibly in your vehicle, and watch for NO PARKING/ SNOW REMOVAL areas. Our Bell staff is always available to assist you. Once again, we hope you have a wonderful and safe vacation at the Iron Blossam. Check for the latest updates prior to your arrival at www.ironblosam.net and www.snowbird.com.

Important House Rule Reminders

Iron Blossam is always a popular and busy place. Compliance with the House Rules help all Owners and guests enjoy their valuable vacation time. We want to remind our owners that in addition to being respectful of the Iron Blossam House Rules, it is also very important that your guests are informed of and respect the House Rules. A complete set of House Rules is available on our website, or by contacting Iron Blossam Owner Services. We do want to highlight some key areas of frequent concern.

Compliance with House Rules:

House Rule #21: Failure to comply with any Iron Blossam Lodge house rule or policy of the Owners' Association may result in the forfeiture of the remainder of your week. Additionally, owners are financially accountable for any damages, conduct or policy violations, and unpaid charges.

Disturbances:

House Rule #3: No owners or occupant shall make or permit disturbing conduct or activities to be made in the units, common areas or pool and spa areas by himself/herself or their family, friends, tenants, servants or other invitees or other individuals over whom they have control, nor do or permit to be done by such persons anything that would interfere with the rights, comforts, or conveniences of other owners or occupants.

Appliances:

House Rule #12: Use of supplemental cooking appliances in non-kitchen units is prohibited. Use of barbeques or cooking grills is also prohibited in units or on balcony decks.

Minimum Age Requirement:

House Rule #20: The Iron Blossam Owners' Association requires that an adult (minimum age 21) register and be in residence the entire length of stay.

Spa Age Restrictions:

The spa area, steam room, hot tub and exercise room are restricted to Owners and guests who are 16 years of age and older.

Please make careful note of the dates for your upcoming week. Iron Blossam timeshare weeks start with the first Saturday of the calendar year. This year week 1 begins **January 7, 2012**. Check-In/Out

We realize, and love the fact, that our owners are always very eager to arrive and start their vacation at the Iron Blossam.

We want to remind everyone that Saturdays from 9 to 10:00 a.m. and 4 to 6:00 p.m. are prime check-in/out times and are therefore extremely busy. During these hours, please be aware that our 37-year-old elevators, our staff, and our loading areas are most likely extended to capacity. Thank you for your patience during these surges in operating levels.

The Iron Blossam staff provides luggage storage for early arrivals or late departures.

Helpful Hints

Plan ahead! Pre-load your vehicle the night before with unneeded items.

If convenient, depart earlier than our peak check-out time - 9 to 10:00 a.m. If convenient, arrive later than peak check-in time - 4 to 6:00 p.m. Owner occupancy does not begin until 4:00 p.m. - therefore we do not suggest early arrivals. Units may not be occupied until the completion of housekeeping services.

Please do not keep luggage carts for extended periods or overnight.
